

Location options for Immunizations

Pharmacist and pharmacist interns are currently allowed to order and administer vaccines to individuals ages three through eighteen, subject to certain requirements.

CVS Minute Clinics- Immunizations are more likely to be covered by insurance (especially Medicaid) because they are categorized as medical, not pharmacy.

- Must bring shot record
